Abstract: Collection, 1947-1998 (bulk 1947-1959), of about 1,600 railroad photographs from the United States, Mexico, Canada, Ecuador, and Brazil. Strengths include steam locomotives in the American Mid-Atlantic, Midwest, and West Coast regions, such as on the New York Central Railroad, Baltimore & Ohio Railway, Northern Pacific Railway, Southern Pacific Railroad, and West Side Lumber Company Railroad.

Biographical Note

Harold O. (“Hal”) Lewis Jr. (1931-2016) was born on July 10, 1931, to Harold O. Lewis Sr. and Catherine Cardozo Lewis. His father was a history professor at Howard University who gifted Hal his first camera. Hal began photographing trains as a junior in high school in the late 1940s.

Hal earned his undergraduate degree in engineering from Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana, in 1953. During college he worked as a fireman on steam locomotives and photographed the region’s railroads. He married Thalia Thomas in 1954.

Following graduation, Hal pursued a career in aeronautics. He worked as an aeronautical engineer for the Boeing Company in Seattle, Washington from 1953-58. From 1958 until his retirement in 1989, Hal worked for Lockheed Martin in Sunnyvale, California. He earned an MBA from San Jose State University while working for Lockheed.

Hal’s photographs have appeared in *Classic Trains* and *Railfan & Railroad* magazines. In addition to photographing railroads, Hal made railroad audio recordings. He started recording railroad audio as a hobby in 1957, and later sold recordings through a business he started with another recordist, L&H Railsonics.

Following his retirement from Lockheed in 1989, Hal volunteered with the Central Coast Chapter of the National Railroad Historical Society and the Pacific Limited Group. He received the Gerald M. Best Senior Achievement Award from the Railway & Locomotive Historical Society in 2013.

Hal passed away on August 27, 2016.

Scope and Content Note

The Hal Lewis collection, 1947-1998 (bulk 1947-1959), consists of about 1,600 railroad photographs from the United States, Mexico, Canada, Ecuador, and Brazil, shot by Hal Lewis. Contents include about 750 black-and-white negatives, 800 35 mm color slides, and 85 4x6 and 8.5x11 inch prints. Strengths include steam locomotives in the American Mid-Atlantic, Midwest, and West Coast regions, such as on the New York Central Railroad, Baltimore & Ohio Railway, Northern Pacific Railway, Southern Pacific Railroad, and West Side Lumber Company Railroad.
